

FASAVA CONGRESS 2017 POSTER SESSION

The FASAVA 2017 Conference Scientific Committee invites authors to submit scientific abstracts to be considered for inclusion in a Clinical Research Poster Session. The submissions will be peer reviewed by the Conference Scientific Committee to determine if they are suitable for inclusion.

Guidelines

1. The abstracts should report recent clinical research, and could be a report of a case series, experimental studies etc. The contents of the poster must not have been published by the closing date of submissions, and it should not have been presented at another conference.
2. Abstracts should be submitted to events@ava.com.au and written in Microsoft Word. The email subject should be "FASAVA Conference 2017 Clinical Research Submission".
3. Submissions must be received by **February 28, 2017**.
4. Please provide evidence of appropriate Ethics Committee Approval for the research if appropriate.
5. Required Information for the abstract
 - a. Authors
 - b. Institution or Practice
 - c. Address
 - d. Email address
6. Abstract Instructions
 - a. The abstract must be written in English
 - b. The word limit is 300 words (excludes the title, author and institution)
 - c. Font Times New Roman 10 point
 - d. Single Line Spacing
7. Format
 - a. Aims
 - b. Methods
 - c. Results
 - d. Conclusions
 - e. Clinical Significance of the Results
8. Tables
 - a. A single simple table or graph may be included.
9. Abbreviations and Drug names
 - a. Abbreviations accepted by the JAVMA are considered acceptable
 - b. Other Abbreviations must be defined by the author by placing them parentheses after the full word the first time they are used.
 - c. Generic names are required for drugs.
10. Abstracts that do not meet the above criteria will be rejected.
11. The Posters must be presented in English and **A1 in size or 594mm wide and 841mm** in height in portrait format.
